

CAGONT 2011 Student Paper Competition

Call for Submissions (Revised April 4, 2011)

The Canadian Association of Geographers - Ontario Division (CAGONT) annually awards prizes for student papers, in three categories: Undergraduate, Masters, and Doctoral. Submissions from students attending Ontario universities are encouraged.

In previous years, the contest was run primarily as an essay contest. Due to the diversity of papers submitted, we have expanded the competition to include both traditional essaystyle papers and research papers. Up to two awards (one for the best essay and one for the best research paper) will be made at each of three levels:

Undergraduate \$100 Master's \$150 Doctoral \$200

Prizes will be presented at the CAGONT annual meeting at Lakehead University – Orillia Campus from October 21-22, 2011.

The following conditions for entry into the contest apply:

1) the text of the paper must not exceed 15 pages, double-spaced;

2) the paper must be accompanied by a memo from a faculty member indicating the student's status on May 1, 2011;

3) entries must be received no later than September 28, 2011;

4) the paper must be presented by PhD and Masters students at the CAGONT 2011 annual meeting. Undergraduate students are not required to present their paper, but they may do so if they wish.

5) co-authored papers with faculty or other students are not permitted since it would be very difficult to determine who wrote what in such a paper. Therefore, only single authored papers are allowed.
