Note: All abstracts must be received by September 21, 2012. Faxed or paper abstracts will not be accepted. All presenters must be registered.

Paper/Posters

Each presenter will be allotted 20 minutes, including time for questions. Poster display boards will be made available for setup early Saturday morning.

Student Paper Competition 2012

In previous years, the contest was run primarily as an essay contest. Due to the diversity of papers submitted, we have expanded the competition to include both traditional essay-style papers and research papers. Up to two awards (one for the best essay and one for the best research paper) will be made at each of the three levels.

As in previous years, cash prizes will be awarded as follows:

Undergraduate \$100, Masters \$150, Doctoral \$200

Prizes will be presented during the Business Meeting at the CAGONT Annual Meeting, University of Toronto Scarborough on October 13, 2012.

The following conditions for entry into the contest apply:

- 1) the text of the paper must not exceed 15 pages, double spaced, not including footnotes or references.
- 2) the paper must be accompanied by a memo from a faculty member indicating the student's status on May 1, 2012.
- 3) Entries must be received no later than September 14, 2012.
- 4) Entries submitted by Masters and PhD students must be presented at the CAGONT 2012 annual meeting. Undergraduates are not required to present their entries. Entries should be sent to:
