CAGONT will provide financial support to students who are attending the Annual Meeting if they are members of the Canadian Association of Geographers (CAG) and are enrolled at an Ontario university or other institution of higher learning.

In order to receive financial support, the following conditions must be met:

- 1) The student must be a CAG member,
- 2) The student must be either the sole author/presenter or the main author/presenter of an oral presentation or poster.
- 3) Students will be reimbursed for their registration costs (\$25) and an additional sum of up to \$75 will be awarded (the amount depends on the total number of applicants that will divide the available funds).
