

CAGONT/ELDAAG 2013 Student Paper Competition (for students attending Ontario Universities)

Call for Submissions

The Canadian Association of Geographers - Ontario Division (CAGONT) annually awards prizes for student papers, in three categories: Undergraduate, Masters, and Doctoral. Submissions from students attending Ontario universities are encouraged.

Due to the diversity of papers submitted, we have expanded the competition to include both traditional essay-style papers and research papers. Up to two awards (one for the best essay and one for the best research paper) will be made at each of three levels:

Undergraduate \$100 Master's \$150 Doctoral \$200

Prizes will be presented at the Joint CAGONT/ELDAAG 2013 Annual Meeting at the University of Toledo (October 25-26, 2013).

The following conditions for entry into the contest apply:

- 1) the text of the paper must not exceed 15 pages, double-spaced;
- 2) the paper must be accompanied by a memo from a faculty member indicating the student's status on May 1, 2013;
- 3) entries must be received no later than October 11, 2013;
- 4) the paper must be presented by Ph.D. and Masters students at the Joint CAGONT/ELDAAG 2013 Annual Meeting. Undergraduate students are not required to present their paper, but they may do so if they wish.
