The Canadian Association of Geographers - Ontario Division (CAGONT) held its Annual Meeting at the University of Waterloo from October 28-29, 2016. The total number of attendees was 216 which is a new record for a CAGONT Annual Meeting! Other numbers of note:

- Total papers/posters: 175 (new record) including
 - o 125 papers,
 - 49 posters (new record) and
 - 1 keynote address by Professor Simon Dalby (Wilfrid Laurier University/Balsillie School of International Affairs).

A huge thank you on behalf of the CAGONT Executive to Susan Elliott and the entire team in the Department of Geography and Environmental Management that made the conference a tremendous success.

The Student Paper Awards were given to:

Wendy Burton (University of Toronto), **Best Ph.D. Paper** and \$200 for "*Raising Social Capital for Green Infrastructure: The Role of Civil Society in Greenspace Protection in the Toronto Region*" and

Hongyu Zhang (University of Western Ontario), **Best Masters Paper** and \$150 for "Quality Evaluation of Volunteered Geographic Information: The Case of OpenStreetMap."

The **Best Poster** was awarded to Peter Wray and Christine Dow (University of Waterloo), \$100 for "*Characterizing the Spatial Extent of a Basal Channel under Antarctica's Nansen Ice Shelf Using Low Frequency Ground Penetrating Radar.*"
